

On Saturday, February 17, the Staff Parish Committee was notified that Pastor Imsook's husband, the Reverend Jin-Jong Lee was being moved to a full-time appointment as of July 1st. As a result, Pastor Imsook's pastorate with us will end at the end of June.

Reverend Jin-Jong Lee's new church will be in Saint Johnsbury, Vermont. At this time Pastor Imsook has not been assigned to a new church.

Her plans were to use her vacation time along with additional time for a sabbatical. Therefore, she will be with us until Sunday, April 7. She plans to be away for 7 Sundays. On six of those weeks Barbara, BJ and Chris will lead worship services. On Communion Sunday, May 5th, we will have the honor of hosting our District Superintendent Reverend Wanda Santos-Pérez. She will be delivering a sermon and serving Holy Communion.

"My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you.
